Truett Seminary is pleased to offer the Texas Hispanic Baptist Scholarship (THBS) to one incoming* Hispanic Baptist seminary student each academic year. The award is a 100% tuition scholarship for 87 attempted hours of a Master of Divinity degree program at Truett Seminary.

This full-tuition scholarship is for select Hispanic Baptist students who have shown outstanding academic prowess, leadership potential, and ministry experience and who have a desire to serve in church ministry, missions, social work, and/or other areas of ministry.

Applicants for the Texas Hispanic Baptist Scholarship must fulfill all of the following requirements in order to be considered for this award.

Active membership in a church affiliated with the Hispanic Baptist Convention of Texas with involvement in a Hispanic-related ministry there.

Minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.25

Completed admissions application

 - 500-word leadership essay responding to the prompt provided on the attached scholarship application form

If selected, the recipient of this scholarship must attend the Annual Meeting of the Hispanic Baptist Convention of Texas.
