

Things to do While in Santa Fe

The Loretto Chapel

Three mysteries surround the spiral staircase in the Loretto Chapel: the identity of its builder, the type of wood used, and the physics of its construction.

Ski Santa Fe

Head up to the top of the mountain to Ski / Snowboard or just to take in the view of what God has created.

If you are wanting to ski or snowboard please make your own arrangements (can be made on site or at skisantafe.com)

Lift ticket \$84 (full day) or \$64 (half day)

Ski Rental (Includes Skies, boots, and poles) \$38

Snowboard Rental (Includes Snowboard and boots) \$38

Weather permitting you can find spots as you drive up the mountain for sledding (make sure to bring your own sled)

Hyde Memorial State Park

Head up to Hyde Memorial State Park for a sledding adventure! The sled run is open daily when conditions allow, and the State Park day use fee is just \$5. Sleds and tubes are not available to rent on site, so make sure to bring your own.
